- 7. The Board will then decide whether to offer you funding based on its consideration of the legal aspects of the case and funding criteria as outlined above. If not offered funding, we will inform you of the reasons.
- 8. We will then communicate the Board's decision. If you have been granted funding, we include a Funding Agreement (A-001) for you to sign.
